



is looking for caregivers for a Recruitment Registry!



What is the Dementia Care Research Core Recruitment Registry?

The Dementia Care Research Core Recruitment Registry is a list of people across all stages of Alzheimer's disease (including end of life) and their care partners, for recruitment into care and caregiving research studies

Joining the registry involves completing annual phone visits with our team. It places you on a list of persons to be contacted for future care and caregiving research studies for which you may be eligible. Many of these studies provide payments for participants.

All visits will be via telephone with a member of our staff and generally last 30-60 minutes.

Who is eligible?

Care Partners must be 18 years or older, English speaking, and have a working telephone.

Participants with memory issues, dementia or Alzheimer's disease must be English speaking, have a working telephone, and have regular contact with the care partner.

What is the goal of Care and Caregiving Research?

The goal is to improve the lives of people living with memory issues, dementia or Alzheimer's disease, their caregivers, and their loved ones.
